

- Became the first redistribution organization of Second Harvest Foodbank to redirect food to other local organizations in need.
- Created nutrition education materials with health benefits, storage suggestions, and easy recipes for a wide variety of foods distributed at The River.
- Expanded variety by offering an abundance of fresh produce, special dietary items, and culturally relevant foods.
- Provided more than food, including masks, hand sanitizer, dispers, menstrual
 products, mattresses, winter wear, socks, flowers, and more.
- Organized special community events, including Curbside Breakfast with the Bunny, The River's Birthday Bash, Make Music Madison, and a holiday gift program.
- Sought regular feedback from clients, volunteers, do nots, staff, and partners to make improvements on schedules, offerings, operations, and more.

Food is what we do best. However, we will always do what we can to fill not only fridges and bellies, but also hearts and souls.

Thank you for helping us redefine what it means to be a food pantry. We are very proud to be one. With your continued support, we will keep moving towards our vision of a fully nourished community.

Program Updates

Throughout 2021, The River continued to grow and improve our programs and services to include:

ePantry

To restore client choice and increase access to healthy food, The River launched an online grocery ordering system, called e Pantry, in 2021. Once a month, households have the option to order groceries via e Pantry. Based on household size, families select from a variety of nutritious food and personal care items, including fresh produce, meat, dairy, culturally relevant offerings, and special dietary options, such as vegetarian and gluten-free items. By empowering people to choose their own groceries again, e Pantry offers a sense of dignity and control and limits waste.

Redistribution Partners

In 2021, The River became the first redistribution organization (RDO) of Second Harvest Foodbank of Southern Wisconsin. As an RDO, The River can redirect food sourced from the food bank to other local organizations in need of support throughout Daine County. Our redistribution community partners receive regular donations of excess food and essentials (e.g., fresh produce, ready-to-eat meals, nonperishables, hygiene items) to reach those who do not access our pantity's services for various reasons. This initiative helps to increase access and to minimize waste.

Curbside Groceries

Dane County residents can pick up free curbside groceries from The River once a week. Groceries include non-perishables, perishables (e.g., fruit, vegetables, dairy, meat, frozen items) and other essential supplies (e.g., masks, cleaning supplies, personal hygiene items, paper products, diapers, formula). Special dietary items, such as gluten-free boxes, are also available upon request. In 2021, The River began offering evening hours on Wednesdays to better serve working families, as well as short menu forms for households to fill out to improve dient choice and minimize waste.

Munch

Our mobile meal program, Munch, delivers free healthy meals to children and adults living in low-income neighborhoods. Focused on serving children who qualify for free or reduced school lunch, Munch bridges the nutrition gap when school cafeterias are not operating. Originally serving 9 Northside neighborhoods, Munch expanded in 2021 to serve the Darbo-Washington neighborhood on Madison's Eastside. In addition to meals, Munch also began distributing free grocery items from the pantry, such as fresh fruit and vegetables.

FAM

Our curbside meal piogram, FAM (Family At-Home Meals), provides to-go meals for everyone in a household to share in the safety of their homes. Clients can pick up meals up to four times each week. These healthy, balanced meals are freshly made by The River's piofessionally trained chefs and volunteers. The menu changes weekly to include meat and vegetarian options, along with a side salad and fresh fruit. Many times a simple recipe is included for clients to recreate at home.

River Delivers

Our contactless food delivery program, River Delivers, works with volunteers to deliver healthy groceries and meals once a week to homebound as idents of Dane County. Individuals and families that acceive deliveries are those who do not qualify for other delivery services and who cannot visit a store or pantry due to barriers, including transportation or health concerns. In addition to groceries and meals, River Delivers can provide the same essential items available to orisite grocery recipients, such as diapers, formula and specific dietary options, upon request.
