

Dear Friends:

The River Food Pantry's 2024 Annual Report details how your support enabled us to nourish thousands of our neighbors in need throughout Dane County.

In 2024, more people than ever before turned to The River for their groceries and meals, making it our busiest year yet. The average number of people we served every week officially jumped to more than 3,000. We broke records for the most households served in a single day, two days in a row—467 on Nov. 19 and 507 on Nov. 20—during our Thanksgiving grocery distribution. In all, we served 18,777 people throughout Dane County a total of 330,833 times through our combined programs. We could not have kept up with this historic demand without you all.

Because of you and our supportive community, in 2024 The River was also able to:

- Break ground on our new, larger, purpose-built facility, which will allow us to expand our services to serve more people in need!
- Collaborate with 36 other local food pantries on a letter to the community, sounding an alarm about the rising demand for assistance and the need for both immediate community support and longer-term solutions to fill the gap.
- Win Best Charitable Organization for the fourth year in a row in the Madison.com People's Choice Awards.
- Host our second annual fundraiser, Sips & Slices: A Brunch Taste-off for The River, when over 200 attendees tasted delicious brunch dishes prepared by 10 teams of local chefs and celebrities and voted for their favorites.
- Continue providing food to Vets Connect: a relaxed monthly gathering at St. Paul Church that offers a free meal, speakers, and a sense of community for veterans and their families.
- Launch our Global Groceries Week Initiative to offer grocery staples and recipes from a different culture, including West Africa, Eastern Europe, Southeast Asia, and Latin America, for one week each month during the summer.
- Organize special community events, including Curbside Breakfast with the Bunny, Southdale Park Resource Fair, The Gifts of Christmas at Santa's Workshop, and a volunteer appreciation event.
- Distribute 57,500 pairs of socks, 3,600 pairs of underwear, and 700 T-shirts donated by Bombas to our clients and to multiple local agencies to reach more people in need.
- **Continue to seek regular feedback** in various ways from clients, volunteers, donors, staff, and partners to make improvements on offerings, operations, and more.

Your ongoing support helped us grow and adapt to meet the unprecedented need, which has unfortunately not slowed down in 2025. By working together, we will continue to pursue our shared vision of a fully nourished community.

Program Updates

Throughout 2024, The River continued to grow and improve our programs to include:

Curbside Groceries

Dane County residents can pick up free curbside groceries from The River once a week. Items include non-perishables and perishables (e.g., fruit, vegetables, dairy, meat, frozen items). Specific items, such as gluten-free food, baby formula, diapers, and wipes, have limited availability and may be available upon request. To improve client choice and minimize waste, people select items they want from a menu form.

FAM

Our curbside meal program, FAM (Family At-Home Meals), provides to-go meals for everyone in a household to share in the safety of their homes. Clients can pick up meals up once a week. These healthy, balanced meals are freshly made by The River's professionally trained chefs and volunteers. The menu changes weekly to include meat and vegetarian options, along with a side salad and fresh fruit.

Munch

Our mobile meal program, Munch, delivers free healthy meals to children and adults in low-income neighborhoods throughout Madison and Fitchburg. Munch also distributes free fresh produce items for people to choose from.

ePantry

Our online grocery ordering system, ePantry, provides client choice and increases access to healthy food. Once a month, households have the option to order groceries via ePantry. Based on household size, families select from a variety of nutritious food and personal care items, including fresh produce, meat, dairy, and options that support different diets, such as vegetarian and gluten-free items.

River Delivers

Our delivery program, River Delivers, works with volunteers to deliver groceries up to twice a month to homebound residents of Dane County. Delivery recipients are unable to visit a store or pantry due to barriers such as limited transportation or health concerns.

Pantry Express

On select Saturdays, we hold a streamlined pantry service, called Pantry Express, which does not require registration. This helps to reduce barriers and increase food access among vulnerable populations.

Food NOW

Our after-hours food locker program, called Food NOW (Nights or Weekends), is available to the public when we are closed. The 10 outdoor lockers contain a short-term supply of shelf-stable foods at no cost.

Redistribution Partners

The River is the first and only redistribution organization (RDO) of Second Harvest Foodbank of Southern Wisconsin. As an RDO, The River can redirect food sourced from the food bank to neighborhood organizations, many of which specialize in supporting members of historically marginalized populations. Our redistribution community partners receive regular donations of excess food and essentials to better reach those who don't access our pantry's services. This initiative helps to increase access and to minimize waste.

Food Recovery

Each week, our extensive food recovery program rescues unused food and supplies from over 60 local retailers, including grocery and convenience stores, farmers markets, and more. This program helps to increase the variety and amount of food we provide while reducing waste.

Food Donors

These food donors made significant contributions of food and supplies to The River. We are so appreciative for their support.

In October, we purchased the land for our future home. Located at 3301 Packers Ave, The River's new site is on the northern half of the parcel across the street from our current warehouse. To recognize this significant milestone, our staff held a small groundbreaking ceremony. We painted shovels and planted our hopes and dreams for The River's next chapter.

We held our official groundbreaking ceremony in November. Over 100 of our supporters gathered on our new land to celebrate and hear details about this exciting project from our Executive Director, Recipe for Hope Campaign leaders, local government officials, and a member of our Client Advisory Council. Despite the clouds and mud, The River's future looked bright as ever.

After many months of working with the City to map out our new property and obtain building permits, we officially began construction in December! First steps included earthwork, leveling the building pad to the designed elevation, and pouring concrete foundations. 
