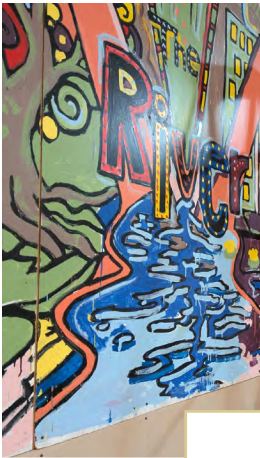

Dear Friends:

The River Food Pantry's 2025 Annual Report details how your support enabled us to nourish thousands of our neighbors in need throughout Dane County.

In 2025, more people than ever before turned to The River for their groceries and meals, making it our busiest year yet. We reached several historic milestones. The average number of people we served every week surpassed 4,000 for the first time, reflecting the growing need in Dane County. On Nov. 18, we served a record 554 households in a single day. The Tuesday before Thanksgiving, we served a record 1,340 to-go meals in a single day. And, we distributed Thanksgiving groceries to a record 1,671 households in one week.

In all, we served **21,329 people throughout Dane County a total of 387,762 times.** We could not have kept up with this historic demand without you all.

Because of you and our supportive community, in 2025 The River was also able to:

- **Say goodbye to The River's original leased space** located at 2201 Darwin Road, where we served a total of 1,147,873 meals and 21,884,466 pounds of food over 19 years!
- **Finish building our new, larger, purpose-built facility**, allowing us to expand our services to serve more people in need!
- **Win Best Charitable Organization for the fifth year in a row AND Best Chef (Kitchen Team)** in the Madison.com People's Choice Awards.
- **Receive the Bronze Award for Best Volunteer Opportunity** through Madison Magazine's Best of Madison Awards.
- **Meet with state representatives at The River and during Feeding Wisconsin's Advocacy Day** to talk about the challenges of food insecurity in our community to help advocate for policies that ensure access to nutritious food for veterans and all Wisconsinites.
- **Team up with rural partners to distribute more food to those in need in Belleville and Marshall**, where accessing fresh food is often more challenging.
- **Host our third annual fundraiser, Sips & Slices: A Tailgate Taste-off for The River**, when over 200 attendees tasted delicious tailgate dishes prepared by 10 teams of local chefs and celebrities and voted for their favorites.
- **Organize special community events**, including Curbside Breakfast with the Bunny, End of Summer Resource Fair, The Gifts of Christmas at Santa's Workshop, a planned giving panel presentation, and a volunteer appreciation event.
- **Continue to seek regular feedback** in various ways from clients, volunteers, donors, staff, and partners to make improvements on offerings, operations, and more.

Your ongoing support helped us grow and adapt to meet the unprecedented need, which has unfortunately not slowed down in 2026. By working together, we will continue to pursue our shared vision of a fully nourished community.

"The River helps us when we need it most. It helps society. It helps reduce waste and the impact of climate change. It helps our entire community. Thank you so much for all you do."

"The River has impacted our family's life by providing food for us. Before finding out about this pantry, we were starving/eating poorly. I wouldn't have enough food if I had to pay for it. People should support The River because people's health and lives depend on it."

"It's not just about the food. All the amazing staff and volunteers revitalize my hope for humanity. I loved volunteering firsthand to really see all the effort and love put into nurturing the community."

"Because The River delivers, I can get groceries after our SNAP runs out every month. Because we can select our groceries from the online ordering menu, I can get food that my child and I can eat. I don't have to choose between eating food that is dangerous to our health and not eating at all. But the most important work that The River does is to treat people respectfully. I have always been treated as a fellow human being, never as a charity victim. Nothing makes a bigger difference."

"The River's services can take the burden of food insecurity off of your plate and give you hope. People are so friendly and never judgmental. It can help you make a better future. We are a family of five. I recently went back to school to pursue a degree, but in doing so, we had to go down to a 1 income household because I can't work and go to school at the same time. We have 3 children at home. My husband has a good job, but it wasn't enough to get by. Thanks to The River, we have been able to cut our grocery budget way down so we can pay for other necessities. It's a temporary solution to get us by until I finish school. I want to better our family circumstances. Thanks to The River, I can. You make such a difference!"

"I am a single mother and live with a growing (and very hungry) teenage boy. The services The River provides to supplement our already dwindling food budget is a blessing. Food prices have skyrocketed and unfortunately less healthy options are the least expensive at the grocery store. I am able to use food from The River in healthier recipes that we both enjoy. I am immensely appreciative for the supporters who lighten the load for those of us who are struggling in the current economy."

"Being homeless, The River provides my family with food when we need it most. It ensures my four kids won't go hungry."

"The River is a convenient place that gives out food to people who need it. You get groceries delivered to your car. How cool is that. You can even sign up to get food delivered to your house. Oh and get this, when they are closed, you can pick up food in lockers outside of the building. So you always have access to food!"

"Best experience was the first time I felt full and still was able to pay my rent on time."

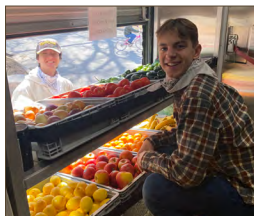

Program Overview

Throughout 2025, The River continued to grow and improve our programs to include:

Curbside Groceries

Dane County residents were able to pick up free curbside groceries from The River once a week. Items included non-perishables and perishables (e.g., fruit, vegetables, dairy, meat, frozen items). Certain items, such as gluten-free food, baby formula, diapers, and wipes, were provided upon request, depending on availability. To improve client choice and minimize waste, people selected items they wanted from a menu form.

FAM

FAM (*Family At-Home Meals*) provided to-go meals for everyone in a household to share in the comfort of their homes. Clients were able to pick up meals up to once a week. These healthy, balanced meals were freshly made by The River's professionally trained chefs and volunteers. The menu changed weekly to include meat and vegetarian options, along with a side salad and fresh fruit.

Munch

Our mobile meal program, Munch, delivered free healthy meals to children and adults in low-income neighborhoods throughout Madison and Fitchburg. Munch also distributed free fresh produce items for people to choose from.

ePantry

Our online grocery ordering system, ePantry, provided client choice and increased access to healthy food. Once a month, households had the option to order groceries via ePantry. Based on household size, families selected from a variety of nutritious food and personal care items, including fresh produce, meat, dairy, and options that support different diets, such as vegetarian and gluten-free items.

River Delivers

Our delivery program, River Delivers, worked with volunteers to deliver groceries up to twice a month to homebound residents of Dane County. Delivery recipients were unable to visit a store or pantry due to barriers such as limited transportation or health concerns.

Pantry Express

On select Saturdays, we held a streamlined pantry service, called Pantry Express, which did not require registration. This helped to reduce barriers and increase food access among vulnerable populations.

Food NOW

Our after-hours food locker program, called Food NOW (*Nights or Weekends*), was available to the public when we were closed. The outdoor lockers contained a short-term supply of shelf-stable foods at no cost.

Redistribution Partners

The River is the first and only redistribution organization (RDO) of Second Harvest Foodbank of Southern Wisconsin. As an RDO, The River was able to redirect donated food from retail partners to neighborhood organizations, many of which specialize in supporting members of historically marginalized populations. Our redistribution community partners received regular donations of excess food and essentials to better reach those who did not access our pantry's services. This initiative helped to increase access and minimize waste.

Food Recovery

Each week, our extensive food recovery program rescued unused food and supplies from over 60 local retailers, including grocery and convenience stores, farmers markets, and more. This program helped to increase the variety and amount of food we provided while reducing waste.

2025–2026 Highlights



Throughout 2025, construction continued on The River’s new home at 3301 Packers Ave, located across the street from our original warehouse.

A major milestone came on Dec. 1, when The River officially took possession of the new facility. Just a few weeks later, on Dec. 23, we closed our doors at 2201 Darwin Rd, marking the final day of food distribution from the 11,000-square-foot warehouse that had served our community for nearly two decades.

The move into our new home began in early 2026, culminating in a small Ribbon Cutting Ceremony on Jan. 29. The very next day, The River welcomed our neighbors through the new drive-thru, efficiently serving groceries and to-go meals to 400 households on our first day of operations.

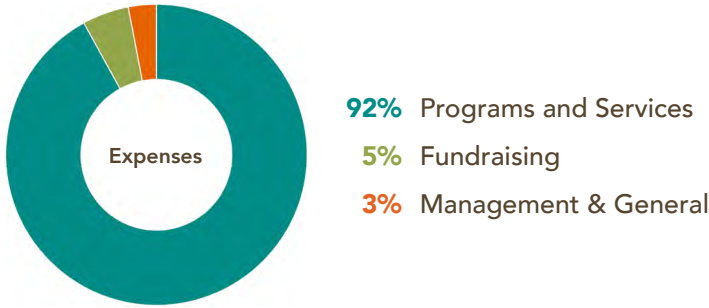
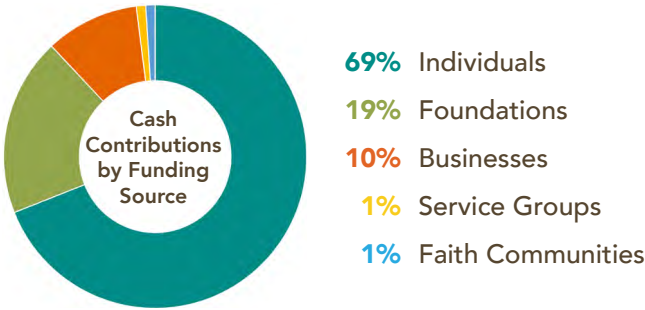

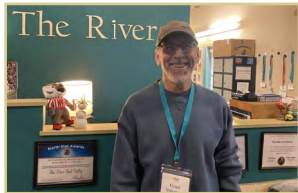

Since opening in 2006, The River Food Pantry has become Dane County's busiest food pantry.

Originally serving only a handful of households, today The River serves over 4,000 people each week.

Our free services include groceries for pickup or delivery, online grocery orders, to-go meals, community meals, mobile meals for low-income neighborhoods, and after-hours food lockers.

The River also recovers food and resources—that would otherwise go to waste—from local retailers.
